CHINATOWN NAVIGATION CENTER/SPRUNG SHELTER

24/7 shelter for men & women & a shower & restroom facility for others living on the street in Chinatown area. Services provided onsite include case management, daily feeding, housing navigation assistance to continue to move our sheltered guests toward permanent housing

SAN BENITO H.O.M.E RESOURCE CENTER/TRANSITIONAL HOUSING

24/7 shelter located in Hollister for men & women residing in San Benito County. Services provided onsite include case management, daily feeding, and housing navigation assistance. Transitional Housing is 12-18 months & provides participants with services to carry out individualized case plans designed to facilitate self sufficiency & stable housing

CENTRAL COAST RESPITE CENTER/BRIDGE HOUSING

6 Bed shelter for homeless adults in need of recuperative care following stays in 3 participating hospitals. Access to meals, case management & supportive services By hospital referrals only. Bridge Housing available to eligible participants in need of additional housing assistance following CCRC stay
